## Notes on interior decorating with wood countertops:

The style of kitchen is popular, using a rich Mahogany wood countertop to accent white cabinetry. The wood adds warmth to the room and is kind to fine china and stemware. The double roman ogee edge profile adds interest to the thick wood countertop. The countertop is finished with Durata wood countertop finish and offers a waterproof and scratch resistant surface. The large island comfortably seats four people for informal dining or a casual gathering. This kitchen is designed with a chef in mind with a small prep sink in the island and a large apron sink on the perimeter. Notice the pot filler on the large stove with a finish that mirrors the window hardware and island faucet finish. The tile behind the stove provides decorative protection and ensures a quick clean up. Just a beautiful and functional kitchen.
